GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

This is a highly responsible, technical position which analyzes workflow, user requirements, writes system specifications, maintains and enhances current applications. This position advances the Countywide GIS program by implementing GIS applications using multiple languages to design, create and modify. Coordinates with Technology Team and Systems Support Specialist for all GIS services and System Support. Additional responsibilities would include office helpdesk, assisting in server installations, upgrades, maintenance, security, malware protection, backups, performance tuning, Website design and maintenance.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Coordinates with Technology Team in designs, develops, maintains & implements ESRI ArcGIS, ArcSDE, ArcObjects, ArcServer, SQL & Internet applications. Integrates business databases & applications with GIS databases that incorporate GIS functionality in existing database applications.
- Install end-user software applications and troubleshoot related problems. Provide end-users with hardware & software technical support and training.
- Assist Technology Team in providing technical support & consulting services to other Constitutional offices and Board Departments.
- Develop & maintain website & web-based applications for enterprise level GIS and PA.
- Collaborates with Property Appraiser & County Information Technology Departments to establish best practice standards for IT/GIS application development.
- Create web-based Interactive target maps to support Central GIS program.
