Job description:

Responsible for technical and analytical work requiring analysis, design, programming, and implementation of information processing systems in compliance with established standards. Work requires a high degree of coordination with customer departments, independent judgment, and initiative. Work also requires understanding and assumption of total responsibility for assigned systems and applications, including new system and integration development, maintenance, and upgrades to existing systems and modules.
